





Werner was a hands on person. and in the early years went out to do installations to see firsthand how his ladders performed, and what improvements could be made.

Werner's on the job experiences led to the invention of fixing clips to prevent the unit from falling out of the ceiling, and the development of a fitted metal architrave which makes installation very easy.

AM-BOSS Access Ladders have always had a simple height adjusting mechanism to eliminate mistakes and to simplify installation. importantly keeping the bottom step the same distance off the floor as the spacing from the other steps.

Werner no longer goes out to do installations, but his experiences have developed the product to where it is today, an industry leader in ceiling access ladders.

The ladder has a commercial and domestic option, and has been installed in all types of buildings including offices, factories, hospitals and homes both new and existing. The complete system is manufactured on site with AM-BOSS making most of its components inhouse, including hinges and counter balance systems.

AM-BOSS pioneered the installation of access ladders into suspended ceilings and has continued to improve its product for over 30 vears. The AM-BOSS design features galvanised steel profiles, especially made to suit suspended ceilings. These galvanised hangers and bracings keep the frame rigid 40mm above the suspended ceiling.

AM-BOSS also manufacture ladders suited for indoor and outdoor use. Another feature offered by AM-BOSS is the 'Top-Opener Escape' and 'Electric' concertina stair. The electric models can be linked to a smoke alarm (optional extra). They are manufactured with battery and manual over-ride in the event of power failure. The 'Top-Opener Escape' is a manually operated system that can be operated at both ground and ceiling levels.
