PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Universal water based acrylic adhesive for various vinyl backed floor coverings.

APPLICATION

Internal permanent installation.

FLOOR COVERINGS

Sheet vinyl, vinyl tiles and planks in permanent applications.

SURFACE PREPARATION

All substrates must comply with AS 1884 and AS 2455 as applicable. In particular, it must be level, permanently dry, firm, load-bearing, free from curing compounds, cracks and also have a high tensile and compressive strength and must be prepared accordingly. Alkali readings to be between 5 and 9.

SUBSTRATE BONDING GUIDE

- Hardboard underlayment board approved to AS 2458
- Cementitious underlayment
- Dry concrete where there is less than 5.5% moisture content or 70% RH.

Contact ARDEX Technical Services for other substrates including terrazzo, ceramic tiles and metal substrates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Refer to floor covering manufacturer's instructions. Condition adhesive and floor coverings to working area temperature 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after installation.

Installation temperature of working area and substrate to be a minimum of 10°C and a maximum of 30°C.

Allow the adhesive 'setup' approximately 15-25 minutes. Setup and Working time will vary based on job conditions, substrate, temperature and humidity.

Apply evenly to a suitably prepared substrate using a 1.6mm V-notch trowel. Avoid concentrations of adhesive and discard used trowels.

Fit and install floor covering into position accordingly. Roll the flooring in both directions using the recommended roller (normally 35-50kg). Avoid traffic for 12 hours after installation.

NOTE: Do not reuse container. Dispose of container and adhesive residue in accordance with Federal, State and Local waste disposal regulations. Do not flush adhesive down drains. Freeze-thaw stable to -5°C. Avoid low temperatures or multiple freeze-thaw cycles.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

CAUTION: IRRITANT. Avoid eye and skin contact. If eye contact occurs, flush with water for 15 minutes and call physician. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Do not take internally. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately. Keep container closed.

During the installation process, adequate ventilation of the work area should be maintained without causing the entry of contaminants to other parts of building.


