SURFACE PREPARATION

All substrates must comply with AS1883. In particular, it must be level, permanently dry, firm, load-bearing, free from curing compounds, cracks and also have a high tensile and compressive strength and must be prepared accordingly.

SUBSTRATE BONDING GUIDE

- Hardboard underlayment board approved to AS1859
- Cementitious underlayment approved to AS2908
- Dry concrete where there is less than 5.5% moisture content or 70% RH

Contact ARDEX Technical Services for other substrates including terrazzo, ceramic tiles and metal substrates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Refer to manufacturers instructions.

Condition adhesive and floor coverings to working area temperature 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after installation.

Installation temperature of working area and substrate to be a minimum of 10°C and a maximum of 30°C.

Apply evenly to a suitably prepared substrate using a 2.4 mm V2 trowel. Avoid concentrations of adhesive. Install linoleum immediately into wet adhesive. Cut, fit and reposition within 25 minutes.

Roll the linoleum in both directions with suitable roller as per manufacturer's recommendation to ensure 100% adhesive transfer.

Full strength developed over 24 – 48 hours. Do not expose to heavy traffic within 48 hours. Do not expose to water from cleaning or other source for 48 hours.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

CAUTION: IRRITANT. Avoid eye and skin contact. If eye contact occurs, flush with water for 15 minutes and call physician. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Use with positive fresh air cross-ventilation. Do not take internally. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately. Keep container closed.


