Challenge

High energy-efficiency, security, and large and easy to operate sliding doors were required to achieve a lightness of the building and indoor-outdoor feeling of openness.

The large northfacing bay window had to be constructed with the smallest possible joint for double-glazing to maximise the views.





Solution

During their research for energy efficient windows and doors, the owners had come across Paarhammer and visited the factory to see how these products are made. They wanted to support a local business who in turn supports Australian jobs and suppliers.

Windows and doors are a major part of this build. Several large lift-slide sliding doors, tilt & turn windows, fixed windows, highlight windows and a modern bay window as well as an entrance door have been custom made in Victorian Ash and double glazing, factory spray-painted with low-VOC stains in the colour of choice.
