It will add parquetry and pre-finished solids, in addition to updating all things installation, sand and finish. This version also gets the name change referring to it as an industry standard. Currently version 2, with version 3 available late 2015.

In place since 2012, as the name suggests, this *e-book* covers all elements of engineered flooring, including production expectations. It fully outlines installation procedures and performance expectations.

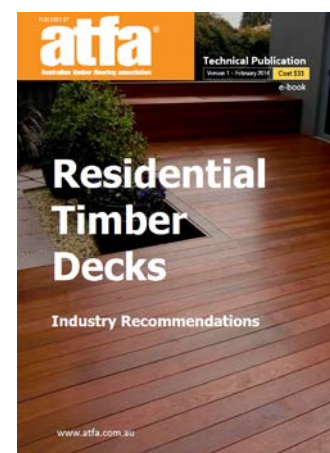


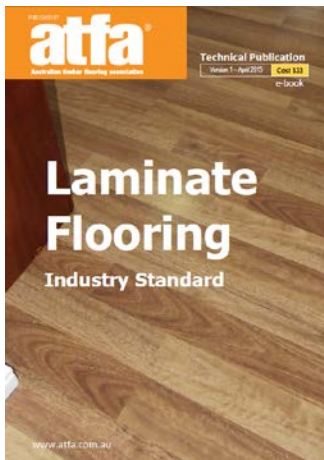
Bamboo Flooring Industry Standard \$33

Released for the first time in 2014, this *e-book* publication has set the standard for the installation of timber decking products, it also includes sanding and finishing conditions.



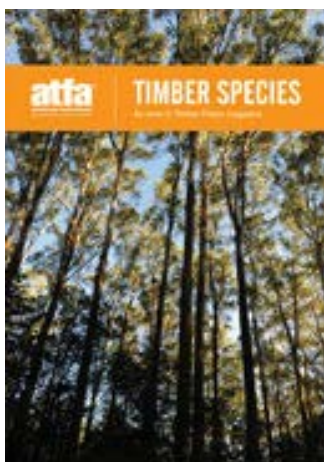
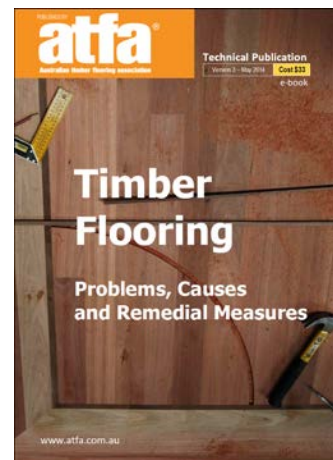


Laminate Flooring Industry Standard \$33

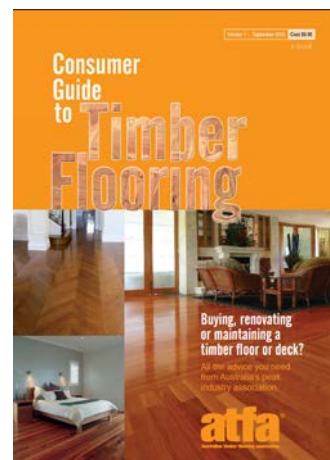


Timber Species Guide \$33
