The Confined Space Entry program equips authorised employees with the knowledge and skills to safely enter and operate in confined spaces, avoiding exposure to hazardous substances, flammable or explosive conditions, engulfment, asphyxiation by unsafe oxygen levels or other safety or health issues (MSAPMPER205B – Enter confined space; MSAPMPER200B - Work in accordance with an issued permit).

Breathing Apparatus (BA)

This BA course provides participants with the skills and knowledge to use self contained breathing apparatus in the work place (MSAPMOHS2 16A - Operate breathing apparatus). The one day course covers topics including checking and operating breathing apparatus, and responding to incidents requiring breathing apparatus to be worn.

Workplace Fire Extinguisher Use

This course is a combination of theory and practical training, educating participants about the relevance of State/Territory fire safety regulation and providing the opportunity to develop operational techniques when using a fire extinguisher, fire blankets and hose reels to put out a live and/or simulated fire (PRMPFES05B - Use portable fire fighting equipment).

This training provides participants with the skills and knowledge to carry out the duties of the Fire Safety Adviser, such as; develop risk management strategies and advise on the emergency planning process. Completion of this course not only satisfies the training requirements for the 'Fire Safety Adviser' role under the Queensland Building Fire Safety Regulations 2008, but meets the national qualifications in emergency prevention, workplace evacuation and the initial response training required to deal with emergencies in the workplace.

Non RTO Training Courses

Fire Safety Awareness - Level 1 Fire Safety Officer

This course will cover all modules required for Health Care Fire Safety Officers (Level 1) as stated in the NSW Health Department Circular 2003/87 "Guidelines for Fire Safety in Health Care Facilities".

The course aims to allow the general employee to develop emergency prevention processes, identify emergency control equipment, develop emergency procedures and policies, implement emergency response protocols and identify the first attack fire equipment to be used.

Emergency Control Organisation (ECO)

This training course is for occupants who have been appointed as Wardens in an ECO. On completion they will understand how to operate as part of an emergency response team. The session meets State/Territory OH&S regulations and is designed to equip wardens with the skills and knowledge to carry out their duties in an emergency situation. Topics include emergency procedures, briefing on fire protection equipment, site familiarisation and an introduction to fire extinguishers with a demonstration.

Chief & Deputy Chief Warden Training

This course will cover the practical use of Emergency Warning and Communication Systems, the theory of their duties and responsibilities, how to coordinate the operations of an Emergency Control Organisation (ECO) and how to coordinate actions to safeguard endangered persons.

Warden Refresher Training

Warden Refresher training course is designed to provide wardens with a review of procedures and reinforcement of previous training sessions. Topics include review of procedures, structure and duties of the Emergency Control Organisation, familiarisation tour of a typical site and bomb threats.

Evacuation Exercise

The Evacuation Exercise is a practical assessment of the Emergency Control Organisation and the awareness of all occupants of the workplace. This is a practical assessment of the ECO and the awareness of the general staff. The exercise includes; a risk assessment of the premises, briefing and debriefing session.

A theoretical awareness session covering the response of employees to an emergency in the work place. The general employee will learn how to react safely in an emergency situation.

Lay Flat Hose Training

This course is tailored to suit staff who are part of an Emergency Response Team (ERT) and aims to train occupants on how to contain large fires until emergency services arrive. Topics include the number of people needed to operate each size of hose, the different types of hydrants and hose lengths, as well as maintenance and hazards of which to be aware.
