On average, our Vinyl floors are made up of 24% recycled content, while our Carpets contain over 60% and our Linoleum more than 30%

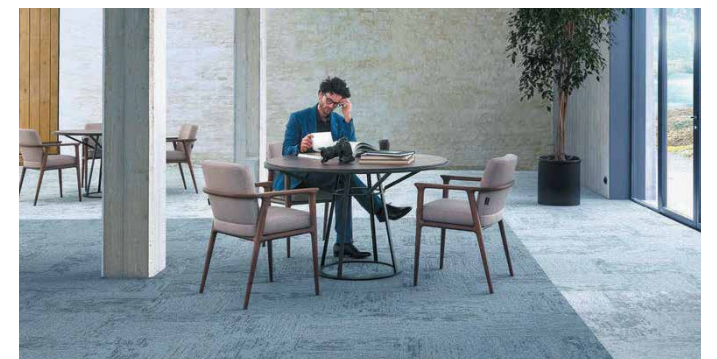

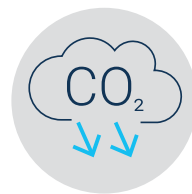

## ReStart® in Australia

Our industry leading ReStart® program is integral to our circular approach and has been available in Australia since 2023. Vinyl flooring waste is granulated in Australia and then sent back to our European manufacturing plants to be reused in our products.

ReStart® will collect sheet Vinyl off-cuts from installation, and select DESSO Carpet Tiles. We will provide you with certification of the amount of material you have contributed with a ReStart® certificate.

Join our hassle-free take-back and recycling program today.

### Lower your impact

Recycling flooring saves natural resources and cuts on emissions from landfill or incineration. Recycling 1sqm of old iQ Homogeneous Vinyl saves 11.8kgCO2eq.

### Reduce your waste

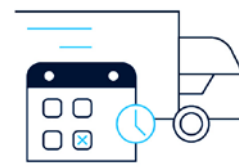


