WHERE can you use Dulux® Professional® DryErase

Dulux Professional DryErase can be applied to

- ✓ Suitably prepared new surfaces
- ✓ Pre-painted surfaces

Remember, Dulux Professional DryErase will only be as smooth as the surface you paint, so ensure a quality writing surface by making sure the surface is of good quality and prepared according to instructions.

WHEN can it be applied?

Use Dulux Professional DryErase in rooms that are maintained at temperatures **between 20 degrees and 30 degrees and below 85% relative humidity.**

IMPORTANT NOTES

→ Measure the area to be painted, Height x Width = Square Metres

→ Dulux Professional DryErase is formulated to provide coverage up to the indicated size on your kit by ensuring sufficient film build is attained, **DO NOT OVER SPREAD PAINT**, as this will reduce product performance

→ Dulux Professional DryErase Whiteboard paint has a **1 HOUR POT LIFE** once THIS and THAT is mixed

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: APPLY BY ROLLER. DO NOT SPRAY

Ventilate: Open doors and windows to ensure good ventilation
